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Shodō is an art form using a brush and charcoal ink on paper, wood plaques, and fabric. It includes Chinese characters (*kanji*) and Japanese *hiragana*. Although it originated in the techniques used for letter writing, with its unique form of expression it has developed into an art genre.

These hands-on workshops will introduce the techniques of *Shodō*. **Students at any level (from beginner to advanced) are welcome to register for these open level classes. Japanese language skills are not required.** Each class is limited to 12 people, and registration will be on a first-come, first-served basis.

INSTRUCTORS:

Tsuyoshi Takemori (Master Biho) has over 30 years of teaching experience in Japanese Calligraphy and has served as the Director of Calligraphy for the Kampo Cultural Center, Inc., in the US. Recently, he has worked at the Japan Calligraphy Center International, Inc. He holds a bachelor's degree in Literature from Ryukyu University in Okinawa, Japan.
