2017 Spring Intensive Japanese Weekend Courses

March 18, 19, 25, 26

The Japan Society Language Center is pleased to offer four-day Intensive Japanese Weekend Courses. These concentrated courses are designed to teach beginners basic conversational skills. They will be useful to people with **travel or schedule conflicts**, or those who were **too late to register or missed too many of our regular classes**. They are also meant for people who are **planning to travel or move to Japan**. Students can move from these courses into our weekday classes with minimal difficulty.

Intensive Japanese Weekend, Level 1 (Miyashita)

For students with no previous background in Japanese. This course will cover chapters 1 through 3 of *Genki I*.

Intensive Japanese Weekend, Level 2 (Kurahara)

For students with some background in Japanese. This course will review the first 3 chapters of *Genki I*, and then concentrate on chapters 4 and 5.

Intensive Japanese Weekend, Level 3 (Nakamura)

Instructor Change

This course will cover chapters 6 and 7 of *Genki I*.

All courses meet for four days on two consecutive weekends: March 18, 19, 25, and 26 from 11 am to 4:30 pm, for a total of 18 hours of instruction. There will be an hour break for lunch from 1 to 2 pm.

Instructors: *All of Japan Society's instructors are native Japanese with extensive experience.*

Ms. Kazue Kurahara holds a BA from Hunter College and an MA in Teaching Japanese as a Foreign Language and TESOL from NYU. She holds teaching certificates in both Japanese and ESL. She has taught Japanese at various institutions, including New York University, Hunter College, Pace University, and The New School. She is currently hosting Japan Society's YouTube series "Uki Uki NihonGO! + Culture".

Ms. Mami Miyashita earned a Japanese Teaching License in Japan, a certificate of Teaching Japanese as a Foreign Language from Ohio State University and a Master's Degree from West Chester University. She has worked in foreign language education for more than twenty years, including at the University of Delaware from 1999 to 2005.

Ms. Mari Nakamura has an MA in Linguistics from The Ohio State University and has taught Japanese for 25 years at universities including Harvard, Indiana University, and the University of Maryland. She has also taught at several Fortune 500 Corporations.
