2017 LATE SPRING JAPANESE, Level 1

Introductory level for complete beginners

Registration opens March 14

The course is designed to introduce elementary Japanese to students with no previous background in the language. Basic vocabulary, grammar and sentence structures will be taught in *romaji* (Japanese written phonetically in the Roman alphabet) so students can carry on a simple conversation. *Hiragana* and some introductory *kanji* will be introduced. Text: *Genki I* (Chapters 1, 2 & 3)
