



## Japan Society's Annual Dinner 2020 Re-Imagined Frequent Asked Questions

### **How can we invite our guests?**

For the 1-hour official program, Japan Society will provide a link to a primary contact person prior to the event. From there, you can share the link with your guests.

For the invitation-only networking session, Japan Society will provide a link directly to all participants prior to the event.

### **Will there be a donor slide/recognition shown during the dinner?**

Yes, we will have recognition credits shown during the program.

### **What is the dress code?**

There is no dress code for the online Annual Dinner. (However, for the networking sessions, business casual dress is encouraged.)

### **How many guests can we invite?**

Table sponsors can invite 10 guests to the event.

### **Are there computer requirements for the event?**

No. You can view the live gala from any Mac or PC.

### **Will there be networking?**

Hosts of table level sponsors will be invited to a post-event Zoom networking session with other high-level supporters. The session will be 30 minutes and will be facilitated by Japan Society.

### **Does this online event replace the traditional Annual Dinner?**

Yes, this on-line dinner is our "Annual Dinner" in 2020, and replaces our traditional sit-down dinner in New York. We will invite all table sponsors and their guests to a separate in-person event.

### **When will Japan Society host the separate, in-person event?**

We will host a formal, in-person event when social distancing guidelines allow.

### **Will there be dinner and drinks?**

While the online event will prevent us from sharing a meal together, we encourage guests to have a meal during the event!

### **Will participants' faces be seen during the program?**

No. The event will not have access to attendees' webcams.
